

CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

We are excited to announce that the <u>Call for Abstracts for the XXVII Regional Pan-American</u>
<u>Congress of Ophthalmology is now open.</u>

Abstracts can only be submitted electronically via the online abstract form. Please read the following information before submitting your abstract:

- Abstracts must be submitted either in English or Spanish.
- There is a word limit of 450 words.
- Each first author can submit only one abstract.
- By submitting an abstract, you confirm that all co-authors consent to the abstract's publication. The submitting author is responsible for ensuring that all co-authors are informed about the abstract's content and consent to its submission and subsequent publication.
- Submitting an abstract indicates the author's commitment to present it. Should it be accepted, the first author is required to present in person, register for the congress, and pay the registration fee based on their membership status. If the first author cannot attend the meeting, he/she must forfeit the abstract; it will no longer be eligible for presentation, including as a poster.



- ONLY electronic submissions will be accepted. All submissions must be finalized online by the specified deadline. No amendments to abstracts will be allowed post-deadline.
 Abstracts sent as hard copies or via email will not be considered.
- All submissions are final. Once submitted, abstract content cannot be altered. Please
 ensure accuracy before submitting, as we will not edit abstracts. The responsibility for
 any spelling, grammatical, or typographical errors lies with the authors.

Please use your most used e-mail address when submitting the abstract. All communication regarding the abstract competition will be sent electronically.

The entry deadline is 11:59 p.m. January 24, 2024, Atlantic Time.
